Each scout is assigned a car number, even if they are not planning on racing. Sibling cars will be provided with a number during check in/registration. Please placement details below.

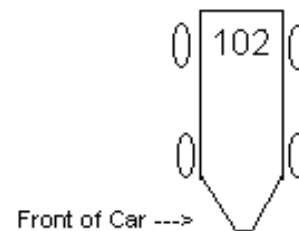
