10	<input type="checkbox"/>	M2	Undershorts (wick-away synthetic, NOT cotton)(wear one, pack one)	
11	<input type="checkbox"/>	M	Long pants or zip off pants (nylon, NOT cotton – NO jeans)	
12	<input type="checkbox"/>	M2	Synthetic T-shirt (base layer) (wear one, pack one)

14	<input type="checkbox"/>	M	Long sleeve fleece jacket or pullover (insulating layer)

29	<input type="checkbox"/>	M	Lighter and flint striker with cotton or lint in ziploc bag	
30	<input type="checkbox"/>	M	Food for planned meals and snacks – coordinate with partner	
31	<input type="checkbox"/>	M2	1 gallon ziploc bags and Walmart bags for trash Miscellaneous	

MISCELLANEOUS

33	<input type="checkbox"/>	M	Headlamp AND small flashlight with new batteries	
34	<input type="checkbox"/>	M	Full set of extra batteries for BOTH the headlamp and flashlight	
35	<input type="checkbox"/>	M	Swiss Army knife or small multi-tool (no sheath knives or blades over 3 inches permitted)	
36	<input type="checkbox"/>	M	Toilet paper/paper towels in small ziploc bag	
37	<input type="checkbox"/>	R	Baby wipes in small ziploc bag (4-6)	
38	<input type="checkbox"/>	M	Whistle – plastic with loud sound. Attached to pack.	
39	<input type="checkbox"/>	M	50 feet of light nylon cord and a caribiner for bear bag/clothesline	
40	<input type="checkbox"/>	M	Toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, and chapstick. TRAVEL SIZE	
41	<input type="checkbox"/>	R	Small plastic trowel	
42	<input type="checkbox"/>	R	Firestarter (cotton balls with vaseline in a small prescription bottle works well)	
43	<input type="checkbox"/>	R	Duct tape (wrap around trekking pole or pencil as a storage option)	
44	<input type="checkbox"/>	R2	Bandana (all-purpose hot pad, sling, kleenex, dish rag, etc)	
45	<input type="checkbox"/>	R	Prescription medications in original containers – coordinate with Scoutmaster
